
# Student QuickStart Guide - ARIS

## First Time Registration

- Go to aris.mhhe.com and from the drop-down menu, choose the book you are using in your course.
- 2. Click on the link "Don't have a Username? Register now by following this link."
- 3. Click on the link "I am a Student."
- 4. Click on the link "I have a registration code that came with my book."
- 5. Enter the alpha-numeric code packaged with the text or included in your ARIS student kit.




### **Your Account Information**
