Looking for the opportunity to apply your ideas and
theories that you are learning in class?

The Maseeh College of Engineering and Computer Science (MCECS) is introducing a new program to cultivate student innovation. You bring the idea and the motivation to see it through and the College will provide the resources.

An innovation review panel, appointed by Dean Su, will select a limited number of projects for award (up to \$1,000 each) based upon innovation, opportunity for student learning, and potential impact. Successful projects may be eligible for additional funding.

Eligibility:

- Undergraduate or graduate student at PSU
- The team must include at least one current MCECS student (*minimum of 1 MCECS course during the 2010-11 academic year*)
- Have an interesting idea that incorporates hands-on learning (*can include components of existing student or faculty sponsored projects*)

To Apply:

- Send a 1 page proposal (1" margins, 11 pt font) to danielle@cecs.pdx.edu by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, January 21, 2011
- Present your project in 5 minutes to the review panel on January 27, 2011
